**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY
(Eastern District)**

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway Clerks that:

(1) Carrier violated rules of Agreement dated May 1, 1955, by establishing a rate of \$315.39 per month for position of Stenographer-Clerk in the Chief Dispatcher's Office at Denver, Colorado, per Bulletin No. 50 issued by Superintendent Columbo of Cheyenne, Wyoming, on May 20, 1955.

(2) Carrier establish proper rate of pay for this position; namely, \$325.66 per month, retroactive to May 20, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of January 25, 1957, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
