PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

GULF, COLORADO AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) Carrier violated the current Clerks' Agreement at Temple, Texas, between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. on September 25, October 2 and 9, 1955; and,
- (2) J. F. Bowden shall now be paid three (3) hours at time and one-half at rate of \$15.39 per day for September 25, 1955; and
- (3) Gus Wauer shall now be paid three (3) hours at time and one-half at rate of \$15.39 per day for each day, October 2 and 9, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 10, 1957, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
