BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE CHESAPEAKE AND OHIO RAILWAY COMPANY (Chesapeake District)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- (a) That the Carrier violated the terms of the effective Clerical Agreement when it established position of Special Report Clerk Position No. A-12, in the office of Superintendent of Freight Transportation, General Office District, Richmond, Virginia, and assigned thereto hours of 2:00 A. M. to 10:00 A. M. on four days each week, and hours of 7:15 A. M. to 3:15 P. M. on the fifth day, and
- (b) That title of the position be changed to conform to the duties assigned and the rate of pay adjusted from \$426.16 per month to \$441.57 per month retroactive 60 days from date of claim, and
- (c) That Mr. J. F. Powell, Jr., his substitutes and/or successors be additionally compensated in accordance with the provisions of Rule 34 for all time worked before 6:00 A. M., retroactive 60 days from date of claim, and continuing until violation is corrected, also
- (d) That Mr. Powell be additionally compensated under the applicable rules for each day he was arbitrarily rearranged from his regular assignment to fill vacancies on position of Night Report Clerk, A-20, retroactive 60 days from date of claim and continuing until violation is corrected.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of June 11, 1957, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
