PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that,

- (a) The Carrier violated the Agreement when, at Eastman, Georgia, effective July 17, 1956, it assigned the major portion of the duties of the "abolished" position of "Clerk" to a contract trucker having no rights under the Agreement.
- (b) As a penalty, Mr. A. A. Johnson, Clerk, seniority date December 14, 1950, shall now be compensated additionally at the rate of \$14.99 per day (plus or minus negotiated adjustments) for each work day, Monday through Friday, from July 17, 1956, until the violation is corrected.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of April 1, 1958, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
