THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad that:

- 1. Carrier violated the terms of the Agreement when it dismissed from service on March 30, 1957, Mr. John W. Dolan, Manager Wire Chief, "DS" relay office, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
- 2. Carrier shall now reinstate to service Mr. John W. Dolan as Manager Wire Chief, "DS" relay office, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 16, 1958, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
