PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(a) Carrier violated Rules of the Clerks' Agreement at Memphis, Tennessee, when on April 25, 1956, it unilaterally removed work theretofore occurring within the Memphis Freight Station Seniority District and transferred such work to the Freight Claim Agent 63rd Street, Seniority District, Chicago, Illinois.

(b) The clerical work incidental to processing cotton claims be returned to the Claim Clerks in the Memphis Freight Station Seniority District, Memphis, Tennessee.

(c) Claim Clerk Walter Apple be compensated for wage losses sustained representing \$6.51 per day retroactive to April 25, 1956, and forward to date the violation is corrected.

(d) Claim Clerk Harold Batte be compensated for wage losses sustained representing \$6.51 per day retroactive to April 25, 1956, and forward to date the violation is corrected.

NOTE: Reparation to be determined by joint check of Carrier's payroll and other records.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 27, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
