# NATIONAL RAILROAD ADJUSTMENT BOARD THIRD DIVISION

### PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

#### THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

## THE DELAWARE, LACKAWANNA AND WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad, that:

- (1) Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties, when it diverted Mrs. M. A. Goodman off her regular assigned position, second shift at East Buffalo Yard Office, to fill a temporary vacancy on the first shift position "V" Office, Buffalo, on April 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13, 1956, in the absence of an emergency.
- (2) Carrier shall now pay M. A. Goodman a day's pay of \$16.848 the daily rate of her position, for each date set forth above, plus a day's pay at the time and one-half rate for the same period during which she was required to work outside the assigned hours of her regular assignment at "V" Office, Buffalo, hourly rate \$3.159, less amount paid. (Bus fare and travel time in connection with this claim has been allowed.)

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of December 5, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
