### THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

## THE DELAWARE, LACKAWANNA AND WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad, that:

- 1. The Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties, when on the 16th day of October 1956, it permitted or allowed an employe not covered by said Agreement to transmit a message of record by telephone from Johnsonburg, N. J. to the train dispatcher in Hoboken, N. J.
- 2. The Carrier shall, because of the violation set forth above, compensate the senior idle telegrapher, extra in preference, for eight (8) hours at the rate of \$2.082 per hour, (Minimum telegrapher's rate) for work denied. A joint check of Carrier's records to be made to determine payee.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of December 5, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
