PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
THE DELAWARE, LACKAWANNA AND WESTERN
RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The Delaware, Lackawanna and Western Railroad, that:

1. The Carrier violated the agreement between the parties when on October 15, 16 and 17, 1956, it required or permitted a Conductor and a Flagman, employees not covered by the Agreement, by the use of the telephone, to perform the work of Operators at Lyndhurst Drawbridge, and at a temporary crossover just west of Hackensack Drawbridge.

2. The Carrier shall, because of the violations set forth above, compensate the senior idle operator, extra in preference, a day's pay at the minimum operator's rate at each location and for each of the dates named in the claim. The identification of claimant to be determined by a joint check of Carrier's records.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of December 5, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
