PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS HUDSON & MANHATTAN RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Hudson and Manhattan Railroad, that:

- 1. Carrier violated the agreement between the parties when it failed and refused to apply wage adjustments and other benefits to positions classified as draftsmen.
- 2. Carrier shall properly compensate: A. Rubino from September 26, 1955 to November 2, 1956; W. Marallo from November 14, 1955 to August 28, 1956; A. Weber from October 3, 1956 to December 29, 1956 for all wage adjustments and other benefits accruable to them under applicable rules.
- 3. Carrier shall apply all wage adjustments and other benefits to the positions and compensate employes occupying the positions accordingly.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of April 7, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.
