THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

THE NEW YORK, NEW HAVEN AND HARTFORD RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on The New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad, that:

- 1. Carrier violated the agreement between the parties when it failed and refused to pay employes occupying monthly rated positions for work performed in excess of $208 \, \frac{1}{3}$ hours in a calendar month.
- 2. Carrier be required to compensate the occupants of the monthly rated positions set forth in the Statement of Facts at the overtime rate for all work in excess of 208 ½ hours in any calendar month commencing with the month of August, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of July 14, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
