## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: The General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers claim that a temporary Block Office was opened at Crab Creek September 8, 1955, and manned by employe not under the coverage of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers' Agreement. Claim is made for a day's pay for C. E. Lenhart who was idle and available on this date.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 13, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Claim dismissed.
