PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Missouri Pacific Railroad, that:

- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on June 13, and 14, 1957, it failed to properly compensate W. C. Reed at the rate of time and one-half for eight hours' work performed each day at Crane, Missouri.
- 2. Carrier be required to pay W. C. Reed the difference between the pro rata rate and the rate of time and one-half for the eight hours' work performed on June 13 and 14 1957, the sixth and seventh days of his work week.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of December 31, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
