STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Illinois Terminal Railroad that:

Carrier shall compensate Telegrapher H. B. Johnson in the amount of \$4.59 for traveling in connection with his assignment on October 3, 29, 30 and 31, 1958.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of February 5, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
