## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, that:

- 1. Carrier violated the terms of the Agreement when on March 7, 1956 and May 13, 1956, it required or permitted train service employes to copy train orders and a Form "A" at Martin, Indiana, a location where no employe under the Agreement is assigned.
- 2. Carrier shall now compensate the senior idle operator for eight hours pay on March 7, 1956 and May 13, 1956.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of March 31, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Claim dismissed.
