PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

ATLANTA JOINT TERMINALS

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- (a) That the Carrier violated the Agreement when, on December 22, 1958, it failed and refused to award Relief Clerk position C-1 to Claimant W. M. Rowland, the senior bidder having sufficient fitness and ability; and further violated the Agreement by awarding the position to Clerk R. D. Evans, who did not bid on the position.
- (b) Claimant W. M. Rowland shall now be additionally compensated one day at pro-rata rate, plus one day at time and one-half the rate of the Train Record Clerk position (\$19.54) for December 25, 1958; one pro rata days pay for December 27, 1958, at rate of Assistant Chief Yard clerk (\$22.03); and one day at pro-rata rate for December 28, 1958, at the rate of Assistant Chief Yard Clerk (\$22.03).

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing therein was waived by the parties and under date of July 21, 1960, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.
