FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**GEORGIA RAILROAD**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

(a) That the Carrier violated the Agreement when it failed and refused to allow Porter Ebb Lewis, Augusta, Georgia Shops, eight hours at the prorata rate of pay for the Holiday April 27, 1959.

(b) The Carrier shall now pay Porter Ebb Lewis eight hours pay at prorata rate for April 27, 1959.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employee involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of July 21, 1960, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Case dismissed.
