STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the scope and seniority rules of the Clerks' Agreement in permitting persons not covered by the Clerks' Agreement, viz., employes of Proctor and Gamble Distributors, to enter warehouse of the West Palm Beach Agency with their automobile truck and load shipments into the auotmobile truck on September 22, September 29, October 1, 2 and 6, 1958, and
- (b) Furloughed Group 3 employe Floyd Harris shall be compensated by Carrier for a day's pay on each of the above cited violations.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of October 26, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
