# BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

## THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, except as amended, particularly Rule 2-A-1, and Paragraph III-2-B of Supplemental Agreement "A", by unilaterally establishing a clerical position in the Car Distributor's Office at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, Philadelphia Region, and appointing an individual to the position without regard to the various provisions of the Rules Agreement.
- (b) The Claimant, Clerk Lawrence Cirillo, should be allowed eight hours' pay a day, as a penalty, commencing October 5, 1956, and continuing until the violation is corrected.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of October 4, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

### AWARD

Case dismissed.
