BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD SIGNALMEN OF AMERICA

CHICAGO AND NORTH WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen of America on the Chicago and North Western Railway Company that:

- (a) The Carrier improperly compensated Mr. Alva D. Davis, Assistant Signal Maintainer, Job No. 102, Missouri Valley, Iowa, Western Seniority District, for overtime service performed 12:01 A. M. to 5:01 A. M., July 24, 1956.
- (b) The Carrier now pay Mr. Davis the difference between his Assistant Signal Maintainer's overtime rate of pay and that of Signal Maintainer's overtime rate of pay for the time and date specified in part (a) of this claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of December 5, 1960 the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
