PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- a) Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement when it scheduled George McCann 10 days vacation for the year 1958; and,
- (b) Carrier shall now correct present vacation schedule to show George McCann as being entitled to 15 days vacation in 1958; and,
- (c) Carrier shall be required to pay Mr. McCann 5 days' pay at the time and one-half rate of his position in lieu of vacation not received for each year beginning with 1958, until he is scheduled and receives 15 days vacation in a calendar year.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of December 21, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
