**CHICAGO GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY**

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,  
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** (3) Claim that three positions of Yard Clerk, Randolph, Minnesota, be reestablished and employees adversely affected by the abolishment of said positions compensated for time lost from April 1, June 15 and June 18, respectively, 1949, account work assigned to Agent and Telegraphers in alleged violation of the effective agreement—Carrier's file K-24, Organization's Case G-395.

**OPINION OF BOARD:** This case is the same as in Award 9867. For the reasons stated in that award, this claim should also be dismissed.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the claim is barred by Rule 40 (d) of the Agreement.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
