BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

CHICAGO & EASTERN ILLINOIS RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that Carrier violated Rules of the current Agreement effective April 22, 1955:

- 1. (a) By use of employes (Yardmasters) who are outside the scope of the parties' Agreement in the performance of clerical work on the third shift, 12 midnight to 8:00 A. M., at Yard Center, Illinois.
- (b) In handling claim of W. F. Phelps, Clerk, Yard Center, Illinois, dated and filed with Carrier's Assistant Agent J. W. Ashmore on May 22, 1957.
- 2. That the penalty claim of W. F. Phelps for a day's pay daily retroactive to March 24, 1957, for the rule violation be allowed as presented.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of December 1, 1961, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to

the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
