GULF, COLORADO AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway, that:

- 1. Carrier acted in an arbitrary and discriminatory manner when it assessed the personal record of Telegrapher R. W. McBride with 30 demerit marks on February 26, 1963.
- 2. Carrier shall be required to clear Mr. McBride's record of 30 demerit marks.

OPINION OF BOARD: Inasmuch as the Carrier's action of dismissing Claimant McBride in a subsequent disciplinary proceeding was sustained by this Board in Award 14248 the issue in the present case has become moot. Accordingly, the claim will be dismissed.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the claim will be dismissed.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
