PARTIES TO DISPUTE: (

(The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The dismissal of B&B Foreman J. L. Wells was without just and sufficient cause and on the basis of unproven charges (System file 130-187-31).
- (2) B&B Foreman J. L. Wells be reinstated with seniority and all other rights unimpaired and that he be compensated for all wage loss suffered in accordance with Section 6 of Article VI.
- OPINION OF BOARD:

  1. After carefully examining the transcript we find that the hearing was conducted properly.
- 2. All substantive procedural requirements in the agreement have been met.
- 3. There was abundant evidence in the transcript to sustain a finding of serious wrongdoing by the claimant.
- 4. The discipline was within the province of the Carrier and the discipline assessed was not excessive.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was not violated.
