STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(1) The Carrier improperly and without justification withheld from service

" Laborer Albert Sachs from 11 . 11 Laborer Wallace Schanufer from 11 18 Truck Driver John Duda from \*\* 5 " Laborer Lamar Purnell from 11 12 17 Laborer Frank Klatchak from 11 11 11 Laborer Franklin Koch from 17 11 Laborer Frank Plusar from !1 11 11 \*\* Crane Operator Raymond Graaf from \*\* 3 to Dec. 3, 1972 (all dates listed above are inclusive)

(2) Each of the claimants named above be paid for the earnings lost while out of service as set forth in Part (1) above.

OPINION OF BOARD: The Board has established by case law that the filing of notice of intent with this Board within the nine months prescribed by Article V of the August 21, 1954 National Agreement satisfies the time limitation and the prescriptions of the Railway Labor Act.

Rule 8 allows for physical examinations of employes; however to contend that the instant physical examinations were pre-employment physicals is stretching to make a point. Claimants were employes in service. They were improperly held out of service. They are due compensation for such wage loss during that period of time.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.

AWARD
