(The Pittsburgh and Lake Erie Railroad Company

STATEM INT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9298) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Rules Agreement, effective September 1, 1946, particularly Rule 20, when it assessed discipline of five days' deferred suspension on the following Clerks November 16, 1978:

G. A. Evans

G. D. Wittman

S. G. Owens

D. G. Wey, etc.

D. Schutz

OPINION OF BOARD: The five Claimants in this case were assessed a five-day deferred suspension for their involvement in a disturbance that took place in Carrier's annex building in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, at 5:15 a.m. on October 28, 1978.

The Organization filed a grievance for each of the five men, claiming failure of Carrier to grant a fair and impartial investigation, failure of Carrier to issue precise charges, and failure of Carrier to carry its burden of moof.

This Board has reviewed the record of this case and finds that the lapse of time between the date of discipline (November 16, 1978) and the date of this award (March 10, 1982) has rendered this case most and the deferred suspension harmless. Carrier, by its own admission in the record, has stated that since more than 12 months have transpired, the penalties will never be imposed and the case is moot.

This Board sees no reason to go into the merits of a moot issue.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjust ment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the issue is moot.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
