STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood
(GL-9216) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not
apply the provisions of the General Agreement and Memorandum Agreement dated
September 1, 1949 for the following employee:

(b) The above listed Claimant should now be paid two (2) additional
days pay based on his monthly rate.

OPINION OF BOARD: The issue in this claim is identical to that considered
in Award 23589. The claim will be sustained on the
basis of that Award.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record
and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are
respectively Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor
Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over
the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
