STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Agreement was violated when the Carrier assigned junior employe J. Newell to perform planned overtime service acting as an EIC (foreman) for a switch install at or near the station of Hammond Mile Post 999.5 on the Southwest Division on October 4, 2019 instead of calling and assigning senior employe D. Van Dyne thereto (System File 2419-SL33-1986/14-20-} Ex Parte } 0060 BNS).
- (2) As a consequence of the violation referred to in Part (1) above, Claimant D. Van Dyne shall now be paid '... five (5) hours overtime at the Claimants (sic) current rate of pay.'"

FINDINGS:

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute were given due notice of hearing thereon.
