AT ISSUE:


Is it a requirement of Article III of Mediation Agreement, Case No. A-7128, dated February 7, 1965, and the Interpretations thereof dated November 24, 1965, that an implementing agreement must be made when it becomes necessary to temporarily transfer signal gangs, including the employes assigned thereto, from one seniority district to another under rules of the current Signalmen's Agreement?
