QUESTION


AT ISSUE: Were the rights of Signal Helper Carl Cooke, an unprotected employee under the February 7, 1965 Agreement, violated when the carrier gave unbulletined work to protected employees junior in seniority to Cooke, in order to comply with the requirements of the February 7, 1965 Agreement?

OPINION

OF BOARD: The Issue To Be Resolved in this dispute, while phrased differently, is identical to that in Award 91, and this Board is governed accordingly.

AWARD

The answer to the Issue is "Yes".
