

QUESTION  
AT ISSUE: Should Carrier be required to pay Leading Signalman P. Weidenhammer, Signal Maintainers J. F. Delp and N. F. Delp, and Assistant Signalman R. Herbein one day's pay each at their respective rates of pay because it suspended their positions on July 17, 1967 during a Shop Crafts strike without giving them sixteen hours' advance notice as required by Section 4 of Article I of the February 7, 1965 Agreement.

OPINION  
OF BOARD: Consistent with the Opinion and Award in Award No. 115 (Case No. SG-17-E), the Board finds that Section 4 of Article I does not apply when positions are not abolished but only suspended.

AWARD

The answer to the question presented is in the negative.
