AT ISSUE:

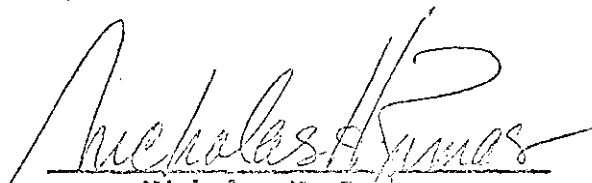
