QUESTION
AT ISSUE: Are Albert McDougle and Albert McCune entitled to compensa-
tion as provided in Section 1 of Article IV of the Media-
tion Agreement of February 7, 1965, or as provided in
Section 2 of Article IV of said agreement?

OPINION
OF BOARD: The record shows that it was not the practice on the property
to bulletin regular positions of the type which Albert
McDougle and Albert McCune might have obtained through the
exercise of their seniority rights; nor is there any showing
that an extra list existed at the time. Both employees
worked full time in June, July, August, September and
October, 1964. Accordingly, we conclude that they held
"regularly assigned positions on October 1, 1964" as this
language is used in Section 1 of Article IV of the February
7, 1965 Mediation Agreement.

AWARD

Albert McDougle and Albert McCune are entitled to compensa-
tion as provided in Section 1 of Article IV of the Mediation Agreement of
February 7, 1965.
