QUESTION


AT ISSUE: Is Signal Helper Theodore Perry entitled to preservation of compensation and other benefits under the February 7, 1965 Agreement?

OPINION

OF BOARD: The question to be determined in this dispute is identical to that in Award No. 111 (Case No. SG-7-SE), and the Board is governed accordingly.

AWARD

Absent an implementing Agreement the seniority rights of a senior unprotected employe are not impaired in relation to a junior protected employe by virtue of the provisions of the February 7 Agreement.
