STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement on August 3, 4, and 5, 1966, by assigning or otherwise permitting the Kane Pipe Works to operate its own truck crane with it's own operator on P-14 at Galveston Wharves, in the performance of certain work of unloading dredging pipe from trucks and loading same on barge.
2. Hoist Helper George Padia, be now compensated for 8 hours pay at his respective rate on each of the dates referred to in part 1 of this claim.

The decision in this case is governed by Award No. 1 of this Board.
