Statement of Claim: Claim of Brakeman T. Cook and others, Ogden, for 150 miles at work train rate of pay on various dates in November and December, 1965 account not used for flagging purposes when main track was fouled by private contractors equipment.

Findings:

This case is very similar to Case No. 4, in respect to the facts on the proper claim dates, the core work performed, and the amounts due to claimants for respective valid claims. Accordingly, Carrier is directed to pay each claimant within 45 days 100 miles for his valid claim (or claims) among the following dates:

November 15, 22, and 29; and December 14 - all in 1965.

AWARD: Claim sustained as above set forth.
