Statement of Claim: Claims for 150 miles at work train rate of pay, plus 60 miles deadhead, for various Ogden brakemen on various dates in August 1966, account not used for flagging purposes when main track was being fouled by private contractors equipment and employes.


Findings:


This case is essentially the same as Case No. 19 in respect to all the elements set forth therein. Only the valid claim dates are different. Accordingly, Carrier is directed to pay to each proper claimant within 45 days 100 miles for his particular valid claim or claims for the following dates:


August 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 19, 22, 23,
24, 25, 26, 29, 30 and 31 - all in 1966
