PARTIES TO THE DISPUTE:

Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees

and

Burlington Northern, Inc.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim on behalf of Group 3 Machine Operator R. E. Gardner, Centralia, Washington, for earnings of J. C. Parker starting July 7, 1977, and continuing while performing service on ballast regulator on Seniority District #24 (BMWE file S-P-152C, Carrier's file MW-84(i) 9/8/77).

OPINION OF BOARD:

The Record shows that the above claim, docketed for hearing by this Board, was settled by the parties.

FINDINGS:

Public Law Board No. 2206, upon the whole record and all of the evidence, finds and holds as follows:

1. that the Carrier and Employee involved in this dispute are, respectively, Carrier and Employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act;
2. that the Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and
3. that the Claim was settled.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
