STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim on behalf of former Section Formeman K. L. Brooks and Sectionmen F. E. Daum and F. J. Daum for pay for all time lost, return to service with all rights unimpaired and their records cleared (BMW file P-P-350C, Carrier's file MW-20 10/3/77).

OPINION OF BOARD:

The Record shows that the above claim, docketed for hearing by this Board, was settled by the parties.


FINDINGS:


Public Law Board No. 2206, upon the whole record and all of the evidence, finds and holds as follows:
