and

Consolidated Rail Corporation:

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- "(a) The Carrier violated the Rules agreement effective July 1, 1965, as anended by the Interim Rules dated February 26, 1976, particularly Rule E-1, when it assessed discipline of dismissal on Block Operator P. W. Foulos, on August 9, 1976.
- "(b) Claiment Poulos' record be cleared of the charges brought against him on July 29, 1976.
- "(c) Claiment Poulos be restored to service with seniority and all other rights unimpaired and be compensated for wage loss sustained in accordance with the provisions of hule F-1(e). Claiment also to be rade whole for any money he was required to spend for medical and houstal services, or other benefits which would otherwise have been covered under Travelers Group Policy CA-23000."

OPINION OF BOARD:

The Record shows that the above claim, docketed for hearing by this Board, was settled by the parties.

FINDINGS:

Public Law Board No. 2263, upon the whole record and all of the evidence, finds and holds as follows:

- 1. That the Carrier and Employee involved in this dispute are, respectively, Carrier and Employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act;
- 2. that the Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved berein; and
 - 3. that the Glein was settled.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
