OF
CLAIM:

- 1. Track Repairman J. L. Howlett's suspension was without just cause and on the basis of the unproven charge of negligence.
- 2. The charge shall be stricken from claimant's record and he shall be accorded the benefits of Rule 27(f).

FINDINGS:

The evidence shows that claimant left the property during working hours in violation of Carrier regulations and instructions. No justification is perceived for his neglect of duty and the sixty-day suspension administered to him does not appear to be unwarranted under the circumstances.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
