PARTIES DISPUTE:

0F CLAIM: Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees and

Seaboard System Railroad (former L&N Railroad)

Claimant E. D. Coleman shall be reinstated with STATEMENT seniority and all other rights unimpaired and compensated for all wage loss suffered.

Claimant was found guilty of robbery, second FINDINGS: degree, in the Circuit Court, Lowndes County, Alabama on August 23, 1983. He was subsequently dismissed by Carrier from its service as the result of that conviction.

Claimant had about 3 1/2 years service with the railroad and was accorded a hearing in this matter by Carrier that was fair and impartial. No prejudicial procedural error is established by the record.

We find no sound basis for setting aside claimant's dismissal.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
