Claim for 15 days' pay for R. Campbell account held from service April 21 to and including May 5, 1969; and request that all reference to this matter be removed from his personal record.

FINDINGS:

In the transcript pages 26-27, Claimant admitted that he knew his Engineer and Conductor were under the influence of alcohol, yet he participated with them in the moves from Lake Yard into Portland without taking any action to report this serious situation to Carrier officers.

The discipline was fully justified and not excessive.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
