STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Appeal of B & B Mechanic T. P. Kilgallon to have his discipline of fifteen (15) days suspension removed from his record.

FINDINGS: In this dispute, the Claimant was found guilty of violating the Carrier's safety rules when he was injured on December 28, 1983.

After a careful review of the transcript of the investigation held on February 1, 1984 and related documents, the Board finds that the Carrier had substantive grounds for its finding of guilt _ to the charges. The discipline imposed cannot be said to be excessive under the circumstances of the evidence before us.

AWARD

The claim is denied.
