STATEMENT
OF
CLAIM:

Appeal by Trackman Roger Zimmerman from 45 days
actual suspension for insubordination on June 25,
1981.

FINDINGS:

The record, particularly the testimony of Assistant Supervisor Palleschi and Foremen Deese and Lorensen, supports Carrier's findings that claimant refused to comply with a direct order to run the rail lifter.

There is insufficient proof in the record to substantiate claimant's contention that the operation was unsafe and he did not accept the assignment because of any lack of qualification on his part.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
