Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employes Consolidated Rail Corporation

OF CLAIM:

Appeal of Plumber, M. L. Armstrong, to have his discipline of a thirty (30) day suspension set awide.

FINDINGS: Subsequent to an investigation, the Claimant was found guilty of a charge that he had taken a Carrier vehicle to his home, contratt to the direct order of his Supervisor not to do so.

The Board finds that the Carrier has met its burden of proof in Indeed, the Claimant at the hearing failed to directly this metter. respond to certain key puestions asked and he provided somewhat evasive knowers to other key questions. This manner of testimony did not help his cause.
