STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

Claim of the System Committee that:

"Claim of Trackman A. J. Anderson, System Rail Gang 6810, for 8 hours pay each work day and holiday as well as any overtime beginning December 11, 1982, and continuing until he is reinstated to service with seniority and vacation rights unimpaired."

FINDINGS:

The evidence adduced at the investigation supported the charge that claimant walked off the job, and since he did not appear at the investigation, he must be deemed to have abandoned his job and the claim is without merit.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
