"Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- The Carrier violated the Agreement when it required Noble Hawkins (Case No. MW-173), Edna Clugston (Case No. MW-185), Lurana M. Day (Case No. MW-186), Alva H. McNair (Case No. MW-187) and W. R. Wheeler (Case No. MW-189) to work during overtime hours, on holidays and on their rest days and then failed and refused to compensate them therefor.
- (2) The aforementioned claimants now be compensated at their time and one-half rates for the overtime service referred to in Part (1) of this claim."
