PARTIES TO THE DISPUTE:

Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees
and
Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company (System Lines)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the
Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the Agreement beginning June 1, 1965 when it required Track Laborer D. Green and Fire Patrolman L. Marshall to suspend work from 8:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M.
- (2) Claimants Green and Marshall be allowed one hour's pay at their respective time and one-half rates for each assigned work day within the period beginning June 1, 1965 and ending with the date of termination of this violation."


FINDINGS:
